PROGRAMS

NEED-BASED FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Our approach is to provide targeted support when athletic scholarships don't cover all educational expenses. For student-athletes who start with two years at the junior college level, the goal is for them to obtain a full-ride athletic scholarship at a university to complete their degrees.

 - 2 semesters of tuition support and health insurance
- Jaime Sigaúque, enrolled at Barton in August 2023
 - 1 semester of tuition support and health insurance

- Support the 2nd and 3rd semesters at Barton for Jaime
- Raise funds to support another athlete who hopes to enroll at Barton in August 2024



PROGRAMS

MOZAMBIQUE JUNIOR TENNIS

We support the Mozambique Tennis Federation to develop talent through investments in training, equipment, and promotion of the sport. Young athletes learn discipline, teamwork, and sportsmanship, instilling values that extend beyond the tennis court.

ACHIEVEMENTS

Supported a youth tennis event where over 50 children from the Bagamoyo neighborhood in Maputo were introduced to the sport.

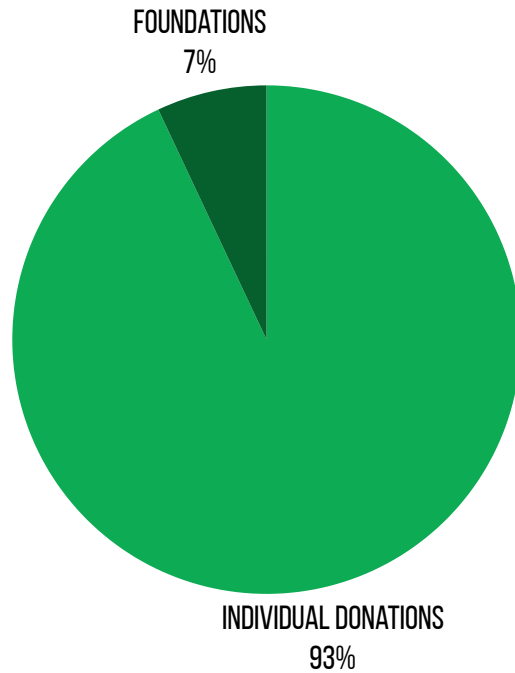


2024 PLANS

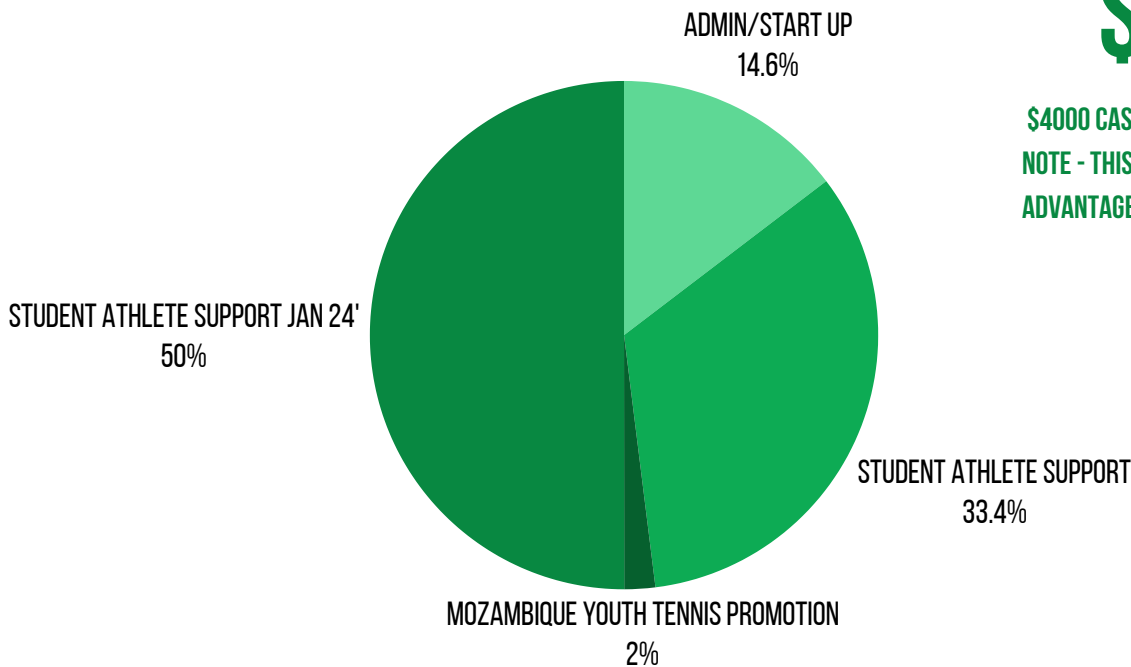
